SAT has 170 questions, 3 hours and 20 min.

SAT- No, guessing hurts your overall score. If you don't know the answer LEAVE IT

ACT- Yes, no guessing penalty, graded on Correct answers!

05 / Please explain your answer for #4!

SAT- questions get more difficult as they progress,
Math has some questions that require written answers,
Essay comes first, required and 25min.
Score is out of 800 points

ACT- constant level of difficulty,
Math is all multiply choice,
Essay is last, optional 30min.
Score is out of 36 points
